



Spectacular Chandelier by Maxime Old, France 1946

Maxime Old (1910 - 1991)

Almost one-of-a-kind Bronze Chandelier with 6 arms diffusing lights throughout white frosted glass disks enclosed in patinated brass shades.

Two tones of Brass and green patinated bronze, and lightly oxidized make this chandelier a perfect combination of colors with the same material.

When the chandelier is turned ON, at night, different colors of the bronze appear to get darker patinas.

The Maxime OLD archives are showing that only two chandeliers are located among his production, one has been made for Maxime Old sister-in-law, Jeanne Lafarge and probably still in the family, and ours.

Our chandelier comes probably from a special order to Maxime Old by M. & Mrs Jay in 1946.
